The simple future tense in Spanish is
used to tell what you are

Going to do

FORMING THE FUTURE TENSE

To form the future tense, you need 3 pieces in the following order:

1. Form of the

verb **ir**
(to go)

2. The letter

a

(which means to)

3. An

infinitive

(an unchanged form
of a verb)

1. FORM OF IR [TO GO]

Yo voy (I go)

Nosotros vamos (We go)

Tú vas (You go)

Vosotros vais (You all go)
(Spain)

Él va (he goes)

Ellos van (They go (boys))

Ella va (she goes)

Ellas van (They go (girls))

Usted va (You go)

Ustedes van (You all go)

2. LETTER A

The letter "a"
means:

to

3. INFINITIVE

An infinitive is the unchanged form of a verb.
In English, we say "to + verb" when talking about an infinitive.

Some Examples of Infinitives:

hablar - to talk

estudiar - to study

practicar - to practice

comer - to eat

beber - to drink

vivir - to live

escribir - to write
