WHAT IS THE SIMPLE FUTURE?

The simple future tense in Spanish is used to tell what you are

Going to do

FORMING THE FUTURE TENSE

To form the future tense, you need 3 pieces in the following order:

1. Form of the

verb ir (to go)

2. The letter

a

(which means to)

3. An infinitive

(an unchanged form of a verb)

Yo VOY (I go) Nosotros <u>vamos</u> (We go) Vosotros Vais Tú (You go) vas (You all go) (Spain) ÉI Va van (he goes) Ellos __ (They go (boys)) (she goes) Ellas Van Ella Va (They go (girls)) Usted <u>Va</u> (You go) Ustedes <u>Van</u> (You all go)



The letter "a" means:

to

3. WFINITIVE

An infinitive is the unchanged form of a verb. In English, we say "to + verb" when talking about an infinitive.

Some Examples of Infinitives:

hablar - to talk

estudiar - to study

practicar - to practice

comer - to eat


beber - to drink
