Technology Standards

The following technology standards have been utilized in the creation of the Moodle unit I am beta testing with my 8th grade Spanish students.

8.1.2.A.4 - Create a document with text using a word processing program.

All the students involved in the beta test of the unit are submitting documents on Word into the Moodle electronically. They are either downloading the Word documents and filling in the answers themselves or they are creating a new document and just writing the answers before they submit them for grading.

8.1.2.A.5 - Demonstrate the ability to navigate in virtual environments that are developmentally appropriate.

All students will be expected to utilize the Moodle. In doing so, the students will be navigating the virtual environment that will be specifically prepared for the students.

8.1.8.A.3 - Create a multimedia presentation including sound and images.

For the future tense presentation, the students are going to be expected to create a PowerPoint or Prezi presentation with images from their future in addition to then recording it and submitting it on YouTube or via email.

All students will be expected to utilize the Moodle, which is a primarily an online course.
